

In light of the new GDPR laws coming in on 25th May, 2018, we have updated our privacy policy. At [Parkview Vet Clinic](#) we are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998, the data controller is [Parkview Veterinary Clinic](#). We may collect and process the following data about you:-

- Information that you provide by filling in forms at our practice. This includes information provided at the time of registering your pet with us, consent forms, lost or found pets or requesting further services.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of your correspondence.

We collect this information so that we can:-

Discharge our duties as your veterinary surgeons under the standard terms of business.

Provide you with information, products, reminders and services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes.

Notify you of changes to our service.

WHERE WE STORE YOUR DATA

All information provided to us is stored on secure servers.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

We may disclose your personal information to third parties

- In the event that we sell or buy any business assets, in which case we may disclose your

personal data to the prospective seller or buyer

- If [Parkview Vet Clinic](#) is acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply to our terms and Conditions and other agreements, or to protect the rights, property or safety of [Parkview Vet Clinic](#), our staff or customers. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

ACCESS TO INFORMATION

The Act gives you the right to access information held about you. Your right of access can be exercised in accordance with the Act.
